# NEWS NOTES FROM THE PREZ

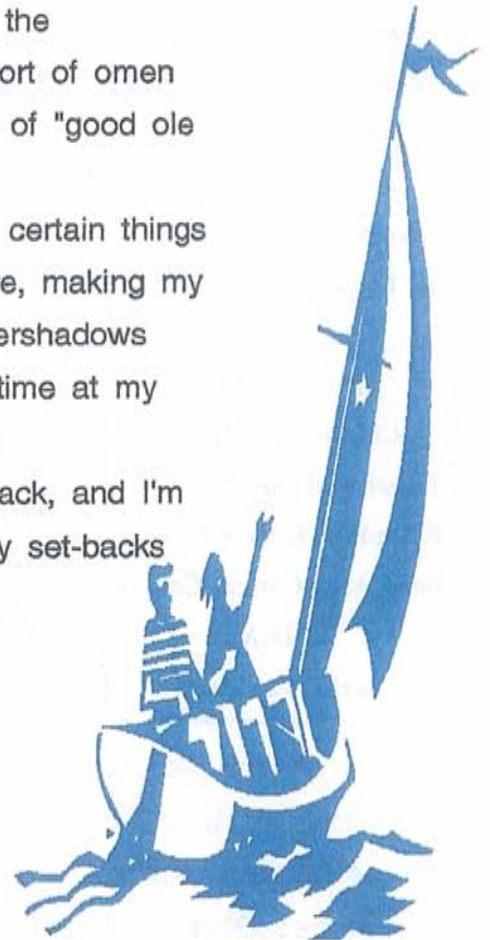
## Greeting Fellow Sertomans:

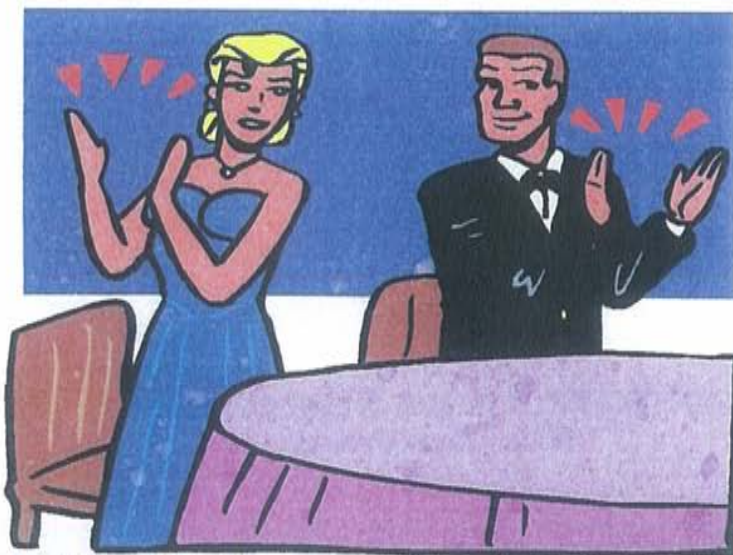
