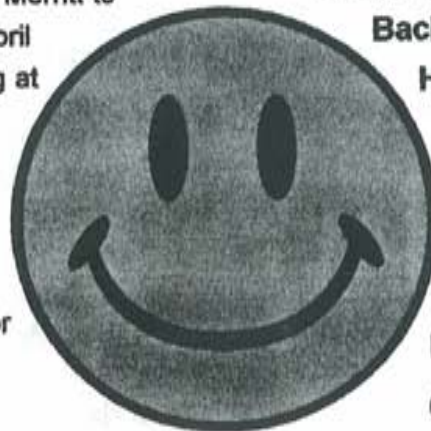
Hearing. Stay tuned for upcoming details. This might very well be the annual event we've been looking for.

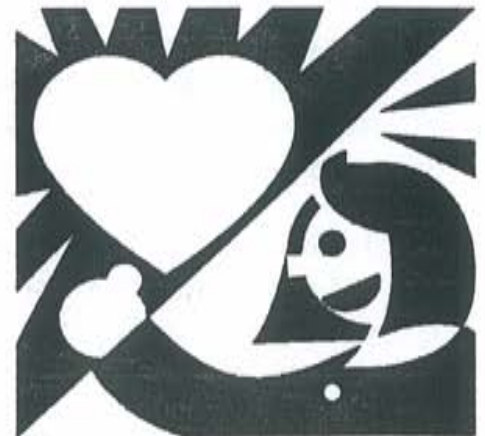
